What is it?

Clinical Direct Messaging is a simple, secure, scalable, standards-based way for healthcare organizations to send and receive health information across all care settings with more healthcare professionals than any other service.

How does it work?

Securely exchange actionable patient intelligence through a single connection—and meet regulatory requirements with ease.



The provider, pharmacist, or staff member selects the end destination from the directory.
